CSL Selection Criteria for U13 Divisions – 2019

Review Criteria that are required for Evaluation:

1. Is the Club in Good Standing? (Verified by their District Association)
2. The Team Head Coach must have their minimum C License Trained. Proof is required at time of application
3. A minimum of 30 points must be accumulated and maintained for admission to this league (Rosters/Game Sheets will be monitored)

CSL Selection Criteria for U13 Divisions – 2019

Fact Sheet

- The Highest Coaching Certification in the Club allows for leadership in the club to assist with the direction of any and all of the teams. The coaching certificate will need to be submitted and up to date.
- The Club Excellence is based on the Ontario Soccer Club Excellence Program status for 2018.
- The Winter Program is based on the training and competition program for the team/s from October, 2018, to April, 2019.
- The Play-Up Options/Opportunities are there to provide the movement of players from a lower level team in the club.
- The Club Support on Technical is the technical structure of the club and the ability of technical leadership to be available to the team coaches in the CSL.
- The Facility Access for Training and Competition is for the quality of facilities that are available for the team/s to train or compete.
- The Highest Coaching Certification for the Team is for the Head Coach to be certified at the highest level possible.
- The Club Support in Administration is for the club to have administrative support for the coaching staff and players.
- The Training Schedule for the Outdoor season is to measure the number of times the team trains in a week. A typical training session is 1.5-2 hours in length.
- The Team Support focuses on the staff around the head coach.
- Please be advised that in 2020, the standards criteria will be in place for the CSL U14 age division. The District League champions that get promoted to the U14 age group will also have to achieve 30 points on the Criteria Score Card.

Additional Information

- For 2019, divisions will be between 12-20 teams. 5 teams will be promoted from the district should they meet the above.
- 2020 division size at U14 will be 16 teams.
- Suggested Playing Nights- U13 Girls- Monday. U13 Boys- Tuesday
- Season will run middle of May to end of September
- Roster Size- 18
- League Fee- \$700 plus HST. \$791 Total.
- There will be a Mandatory Festival on October 13/14 for all teams that apply. Teams will play 2-3 games over the weekend. While this will not determine if you are accepted, it will give clubs an indication whether their teams will be competitive in the league. There will be no cost to the teams. Following the festival, if a club determines they wish to withdraw their application, they will have their league fee refunded.
